Important:

- A change is generally only possible before the start of the course.
- A change must be permitted by the headmaster.
- A change is only possible if the opening number of students will not be not lower than 5. Courses are not allowed to collapse (also due to the students leaving the country or repeating the school year).
- If for whatever reason the re-choice was given its OK, and the course still collapses later (due students leaving the school or repeating, etc), then we will **revoke the change**. This means that you have to go to the original course that you chose.
- It is not necessary to fill out this form, if Mr. Kim requests that you change a course.

Procedure:

- Contact Mr. Kim to find out of a change in subjects results in a collapsing of the course due to low number of students. If this is the case, then the change will not be permitted.

- Bring the the other copy of the form to Mr. Kim.
